Dear Friends of The Hunger Project,

As the corona virus is spreading significantly worldwide, The Hunger Project (THP) is also taking protective measures in its offices and supported communities. International travel is prohibited for all staff members and staff members are not allowed to receive international visitors. In our programme countries (Ethiopia, Benin, Burkina Faso, Ghana, Malawi, Mozambique, Senegal, Uganda, Bangladesh, India, Mexico and Peru) business travel from the local office to the communities is prohibited. This is to slow down the spread of the virus into rural areas.

The essence of how THP works is more important than ever: we will continue to enable our supported communities to access reliable information and needed services, and we will continue to support their leadership and resilience in the face of challenges. We will find new ways to do this, now that we are rapidly entering a phase where face-to-face contact must be kept to a minimum (e.g. in the form of virtual meetings).

We are aware that these measures may slow down or change some programmatic work. This period may lead to new innovations that could also strengthen our programs. The key is that we move quickly while maintaining our commitment to our mission and to our partners in the community. We will inform you as soon as we have more details.
